### International Cholangiocarcinoma Patient Registry (ICPR)

- Only registry of patient health information related solely to cholangiocarcinoma
- Private, secure, online, patient-centered database
- Collects relevant clinical and scientific information to provide doctors, researchers, and patients an unprecedented resource of data about family history, risk factors, test results and more
- Accelerates research for early detection, diagnosis, new treatments and ultimately a cure for cholangiocarcinoma

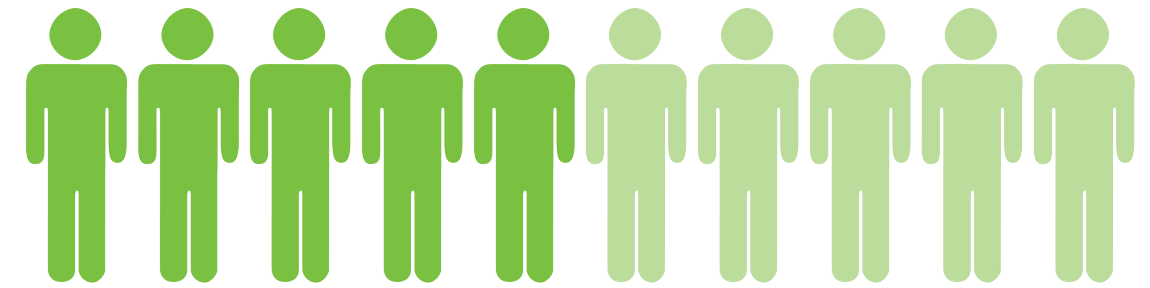
### 100 Questions & Answers about Biliary Cancer

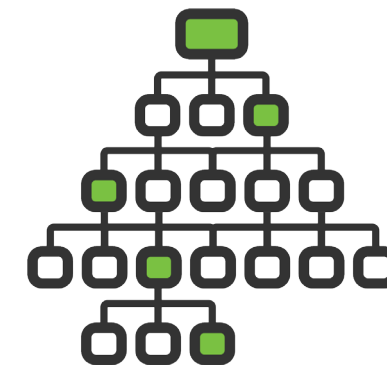
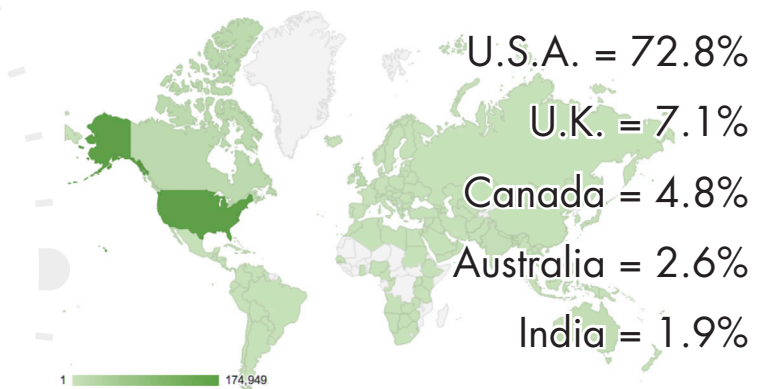
